## Deputies Injured Arresting Suspect in Stolen Vehicle

At about 8:30 this morning, deputies were dispatched to a call of a man in a car who was not known to the area on Mayfield Drive in Boulder Creek. When deputies arrived, the suspect saw deputies and reversed his car, which collided with another car. This collision forced a parked car into one of our patrol cars. The suspect drove in the direction of two deputies and struck another car while trying to get away. The suspect reversed the car in the direction of two deputies again and drove down a driveway and crashed through a fence. The suspect continued down the road into a culvert where he crashed into a tree. The suspect got out of the car and ran into the woods but was apprehended after a short chase. The suspect continued to be combative after being placed under arrest and tried to kick out the windows in the patrol car.

Two deputies were injured during the arrest and are receiving medical care at a local hospital. The injuries to both deputies are not life threatening. The vehicle the suspect was driving had been reported stolen out of San Jose from a dealership. The identity of the suspect is not known at this time. The suspect will be booked into the Santa Cruz County Jail for charges of assault with a deadly weapon, possession of a stolen vehicle, and resisting arrest.
