## **Santa Cruz County Law Enforcement Firearms Buy-Back**

### **Cash for Guns**

The Santa Cruz County Law Enforcement Chief's Association, Monarch Services, Peace United Church, Lutheran Community Church and the Youth Violence Prevention Task Force are working together to reduce the availability of guns in our county by sponsoring a Firearms Buy Back.

The Buy Back will occur on Saturday March 24, 2018 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at two locations:

North County: Santa Cruz Sheriff's Office, 5200 Soquel Avenue Santa Cruz 95062

South County: Watsonville Fire Station #1, 115 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Watsonville 95076

Members of the public participating in the buy-back do not have to identify themselves. All firearms will be accepted for disposal and destruction.

While funds last, individuals will receive payment for qualifying firearms: \$50 per rifle or shotgun; \$100 per handgun; \$200 per assault rifle. Qualifying firearms must be complete and operable; antique firearms do not qualify for payment.

Firearms should be transported to the collection sites unloaded in the trunk of a vehicle. Ammunition will not be accepted and ammunition should not be anywhere in the vehicle during the buy-back. All firearms collected will be destroyed unless the gun was previously reported stolen, in which case it will be returned to the owner.
